A Time To Reflect

Los Angeles, CA.----On May 6, 2006 Singer, Song/Writer, Tim Myers wrote *Hey What's New*, a song that honors the 16 million who served in the Armed Forces of the United States during World War II. Tim had always thought that while we honor celebrities and sports figures, we sometimes overlook our real heroes, American service men and women who stand up to defend America and our way of life, especially the vets from WWII. "Hey, What's New" says our WWII vets are, "what was new", and should not be forgotten.

Another song of the era, *War Baby* was written to praise mothers of war babies, and say, "it's OK". There is no shame, only celebration to have brought a child into the world. War babies thank the mothers who raised them and tell them, the "kids" are just happy to be here.

The songs are included in Tim's debut album, ***Outta Nowhere*** that was self-released in March. Recorded in Santa Monica, CA producer Ned Albright put together an incredible line up of musicians, including Dr. John Ciambotti who plays base guitar, Herman Mathews (drummer for Stevie Wonder and Tom Jones), lead guitarist for Country Music star Lucinda Williams, Doug Pettibone, Folk Pickers Brantley Kearnes (Fiddle & Mandolin), Skip Edwards (Accordion & Organ) and back ground singers, Gia Ciambotti and Kim Yarboro
